

GERMANIC LANGUAGES AND LITERATURES (GER)

GER 101 (4 credit hours)

Elementary German I

Includes fundamentals of German with development of the four basic skills: reading, writing, listening, and speaking. Lecture: 4 credits (60 contact hours).

Attributes: Foreign Language, Cultural Competence

Components: LEC: Lecture

GER 102 (4 credit hours)

Elementary German II

Continues the fundamentals of GER 101 with further development of the four basic skills: reading, writing, listening, and speaking. Lecture: 4 credits (60 contact hours).

Pre-requisite: GER 101 or Consent of Instructor.

Attributes: Foreign Language, Cultural Competence

Components: LEC: Lecture

GER 201 (3 credit hours)

Intermediate German I

Includes the systematic review of grammar and furthering of reading, writing, listening, and speaking skills based upon cultural and literary materials. Lecture: 3 credits (45 contact hours).

Pre-requisite: GER 102, or equivalent or placement test.

Attributes: Foreign Language, Cultural Competence

Components: LEC: Lecture

GER 202 (3 credit hours)

Intermediate German II

Continues the study of intermediate German through grammar, reading, and oral practice. Lecture: 3 credits (45 contact hours).

Pre-requisite: GER 201 or equivalent or placement test.

Attributes: Foreign Language, Cultural Competence
