The Veterinary Technology program will provide students with the skills and knowledge needed to work as a professional veterinary technician.

Areas of study include the nine domains included on the Veterinary Technician Licensing Exam:

1. Pharmacy & Pharmacology
2. Surgical Nursing;
3. Dentistry;
4. Laboratory Procedures;
5. Animal Care & Nursing;
6. Diagnostic Imaging;
7. Anesthesia;
8. Emergency Medicine & Critical Care and
9. Pain Management & Analgesia.

The Veterinary Technology program will provide students with “real world” clinical and laboratory experiences to develop the skills needed to become a valued professional in the field.
